**Premier Soccer Academies Announces
Eight From United States That Will Attend
Academy This Summer**

**Northeast Ohio student-athlete is one of the early invites for
the first-ever class of PSA Residency Members**

Lorain, Ohio. - Brad Friedel's Premier Soccer Academies, the first full-scholarship youth soccer academy in the United States, have now received a total of fifteen commitments from student-athletes recently invited to attend the Academy beginning August 2007.

Each of the fifteen student-athletes have been scouted either through the PSA Identification (ID) Camps or assessed from the PSA England Tour and PSA Bolivia Tour. Five of the student-athletes were part of the PSA Bolivia Team that competed in the Tahuichi Mundialito Cup held in Bolivia earlier this year. Teams such as Chivas (Mexico), San Paolo (Brazil), Danubio (Uruguay), and of course Tahuichi (Bolivia) were participants of this world-class event.

Eight of the fifteen committed student-athletes are from the United States. The other seven are from Brazil, Trinidad, Chile, Bolivia, and Venezuela. All international student-athletes will be announced this summer following completion of the necessary immigration and guardianship applications.

Of the eight U.S. student-athletes currently committed to the PSA, Ohio and Maryland each produce three outstanding recruits. Virginia and Texas are also represented with one recruit coming from each of those states.

From this group, two of the seven are goalkeepers and both live in the Buckeye state of Ohio. Andrian McAdams from Oberlin, Ohio is one of the prized goalkeeper recruits heading to the PSA this fall.

“Andrian is a special selection for Premier Soccer Academies due to the fact that he is a goalkeeper and that he is also from Northern Ohio just like the founder of PSA Brad Friedel,” said Desmond Armstrong, PSA Director of Scouting. “Brad's desire to place a world-class youth soccer academy in the community he grew up in says a lot about who he is and what he wants to give back to the area, specifically local youth soccer players. He was given an opportunity that many kids can only dream about, by building this facility in northeast Ohio, he will bring that dream much closer to reality and one such player given that opportunity is Andrian.”

"It's exciting to have this academy with some of the best coaches and players from around the world so close to my home. I'm very grateful for the opportunity to be part of such a unique and professional soccer experience," said Andrian McAdams.

“Andrian is very composed and technically sound for his age, He has a good grasp of the game and the positioning of his defense in front of him,” said Armstrong. “His time spent with Roy Tunks, our Director of Goalkeeping, will allow even more of his talents to come out as he learns more of the goalkeeping techniques successfully implemented in Europe.”

The total number of year-round Academy student-athletes for the inaugural 2007/2008 academic year is anticipated to top out at 24 even though the maximum for the residential component is 30. “This first year we want to make sure we have a manageable number of students in-house,” said Craig Umland, Chief Operating Officer at PSA. “With that being said, we still have a large number recruiting opportunities still to take place this summer which, depending on the level of talent, might mean us inviting a few more student athletes to our year-round program. Our PSA ID Camps and National Fever 5 Futbol Tournaments might yield a few players not already on our radar screens.”

Desmond Armstrong, and members of the PSA Scout Team, will be attending the multiple PSA ID Camps and PSA National Fever 5 Futbol Tournaments scheduled for the summer of 2007. It is anticipated that final selections for the year-round academy members will be completed at the conclusion of the Ohio and Denver Fever 5 Futbol Tournaments later this summer.
